



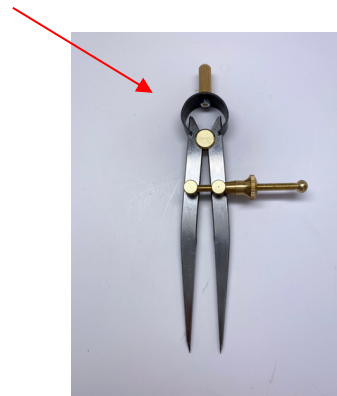
SUPPLY LIST FOR BYZANTINE DRAWING I

REQUIRED:

- (1) Min. 12" Straight edge - larger is better
- (1) small box of colored pencils (Crayola is fine)
- (1) 9" x 12" sketch pad
- (1) 9" x 12" tracing paper pad
- Sketching pencil(s) (mechanical or wooden) HB is good
- (1) large plastic right angle
- (1) compass (see below)
- (1) 8" Divider (drafting caliper – see suggestion below)
- Eraser
- Pencil sharpener
- 4:1 Ratio Graph Paper
- Artist Tape or Architect Dots (low tack adhesive)

8" CALIPERS or DIVIDERS:

(pull apart easily –Alvin brand is nice but not necessary): **NOT THESE (wheel takes forever to adjust):**

COMPASS: Compass with legs to adjust. (If you plan to go on to Iconography painting, purchase one with scribing points.) The spring-loaded arms (gray pads beneath the adjustment bar) make it easy to pull open to the right distance for large adjustment, while the wheel makes minor adjustments.
