REQUIRED:

	(1) Min. 12" Straight edge - larger is better
	(1) small box of colored pencils (Crayola is fine)
	(1) 9" x 12" sketch pad
	(1) 9" x 12" tracing paper pad
	Sketching pencil(s) (mechanical or wooden) HB is good
	(1) large plastic right angle
	(1) compass (see below)
	(1) 8" Divider (drafting caliper – see suggestion below)
	Eraser

☐ 4:1 Ratio Graph Paper

(pull apart easily –Alvin brand is nice but not necessary): NOT THESE (wheel takes forever to adjust):

COMPASS: Compass with legs to adjust. (If you plan to go on to Iconography painting, purchase one with scribing points.) The spring-loaded arms (gray pads beneath the adjustment bar) make it easy to pull open to the right distance for large adjustment, while the wheel makes minor adjustments.
