Zemen Monastery built 9-10th century; 14th century frescoes

Vlatadon Monastery -(UNESCO) functioning Byzantine Monastery & 1/15 paleochristian monuments.

Church of Hosias David (UNESCO)-5th century church founded by Theodora.

Church of Prophet Elijah (UNESCO)-14th century frescoes from the Palaiologan era.

Church of St. Catherine (UNESCO) - 14th century frescoes.

Church of Holy Apostles (UNESCO) - Constantinopolitan mosaics

Church of Nicholas Orphanos (UNESCO) -Iconography by M. Astrapas & Eutychios

Church of St. Stephen - rare 9-10th & 11-12th century frescoes.

Monastery of Panagia Mavriotissa - beautiful environs surround an 11th century monastery, frescoed in the 1200 - 1600s.
